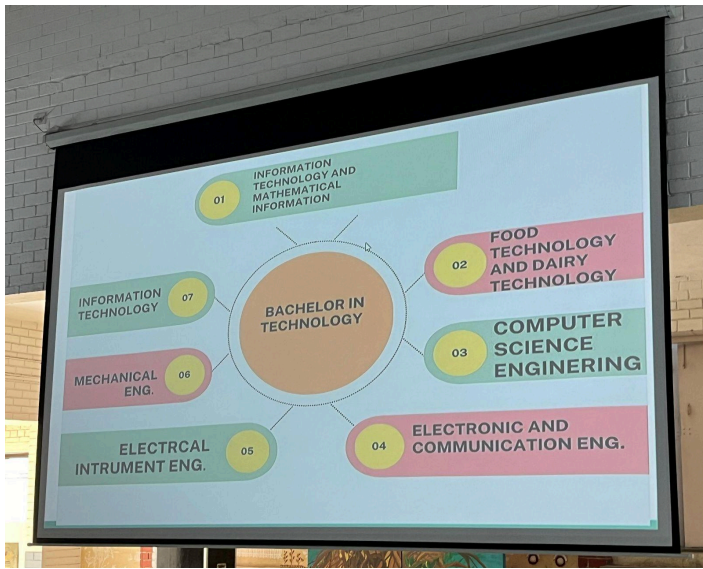
Report :

On 24th April 2024, the school organized a session on CUET conducted by Mr Karan Nagpal for the students of class 11th and 12th (Commerce and Humanities stream). The session commenced with an introduction to the importance of CUET and its significance in shaping the academic and professional future of students. The resource person provided insights into the structure, format, and syllabus of the CUET exam, tailored to the needs of the students.

Mr Karan elucidated on the examination pattern, including the types of questions & marking scheme in the CUET exam.

A comprehensive overview of the syllabus and subject combinations required for appearing in the CUET exam from commerce and humanities streams was provided. The session delved into subject-specific guidance, offering tips and techniques for each subject area relevant to both streams, including Mathematics, Economics, Accountancy, History, Political Science, and Geography etc.

The session concluded with a mock questionnaire filled by the students present and an interactive question and answer session towards the end.

Candidates must appear in CUET in any of the following subject combinations:
 Combination I: Any one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2
 OR
 Combination II: Any one Language from List A + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2 + SECTION III of CUET (General Test)
