
# Curriculum Inputs of K.G. for the months of July, August & September 2024

# English-

Reads fluently words with vowel 'a', 'i' and 'o' (ot ending). e.g. - far, jam, bin, pit, sip, rim, hot etc. and understands their meanings.



\* Matches words to their pictures correctly -



- Reads words from variety of texts like newspapers, magazines, menucards etc.
- \* Reads simple sentences fluently and illustrates their meanings clearly.

  e.g. The jam is in the jar. A pig is in the pit.





Cut and pastes the correct letter in the blank to make a meaningful word.

- Plays word chain game.e.g., far- ram- mat- tip
- Identifies the rhyming word to a given word. e.g., sad-lad, pit-sit, jar-far

\* Recognizes numbers from 7 to 16 and associates them using household objects like blocks, crayons, spoons etc.

Identifies the biggest/smallest number from the given numbers (0-16).e.g.



- 15 is the biggest number

- 3 is the smallest number.
- Disintegrates a number in all possible 2 parts (concept of number bonds).



- ❖ Counts backwards from 5 to 1.
- \* Recites number rhymes with rhythmic movement.e.g.
  - > 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive...
  - One two buckle my shoe....
  - ❖ Identifies Indian currency coins (1, 2, 5, 10) and notes (10).

#### My Family

Differentiates between a 'big family' and a 'small family' and places his/her in family in the above categories.

\* Enacts role play of different family members.



Discusses how he/she spends time with family.

#### My House

- Expresses the importance of a house to living being.
- Talks about how to use home furniture differently.
  - e.g.: living area furniture for reading.



Describes usage of commonly available technological tools like T.V., remotes, mobile phones and others available in house.

## Our Neighbourhood and Helpers

- Identifies self as a member of a family, neighbourhood, school, city withdifferent people doing different roles.
  - Understands how the community helpers like Doctor, Teacher, Farmer, Firefighter etc. makes our lives easy and what equipment

they use.



Talks to the people who help us in school like sweeper, gardener, guardetc. and identifies their tools.



- Enacts the role of any community helper and other children guess which role the child is playing.
- Solve riddles on our helpers.



## My School

Walks through the school premises and familiarizes with different areas in the school.



#### Rainy Season

Observes the changes in the environment- overcast sky, thunder, lightning, puddles of water, snails and earthworms





Classifies the different types of plants during nature walk.




Recalls the names of a few shady trees around the house and in school and understands their importance e.g., Neem, Peepal, Jamun, Mango etc.

through drawings.




Learns about different parts of a plant and conditions that are necessary for a plant to grow. e.g., soil, sun, water and air.







Understands the importance of planting trees for life on earth and discusses about different things we get from plants. e.g., wood, fruits, vegetables, cotton, medicines and oxygen. Appreciates the importance of plants to enhance one's immunity like the use of turmeric, tulsi, garlic etc.



Identifies the various fruits and vegetables and learns their English/Hindi names. Classifies them according to their number of seeds, season, colour and taste.






Observes and identifies different things in nature like flower, butterflies, different types of leaves etc during Nature walk.

#### Animal Life

- Classifies animals into pet/ farm / wild.
- ❖ Identifies common Pet animals in the immediate surroundings. Talks about their physical features, eating habits, habitat etc. using picture cards, books, powerpoint presentation etc.



 Solves riddles related to animals.E.g.



- Uses importance, properties, and state of water. Talks about uses of water and how we can save water.
- Talks about Sun/Moon/Star and phases of moon.
- ❖ Learns about basic life skills, like keeping their classroom clean, tucking their shirts in the waistband etc.
- \* Recites rhymes related to the ongoing themes. E.g.

  - My cat likes to purr...
  - Doctor, doctor come and see...
  - Performs science activities, observes and speaks about it.
