


FOOD




SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES TO BE DONE AT HOME

Articles Board Game

Students will take a printout of this board game on an A-4 sheet and can play this game in a group of 3-4 children. For playing this game, the players will need a dice, counters and a pencil for writing their scores. Each player will place their counters on the start square and take turns to roll the dice and move their counter along the board. Players will place counters on the start square. They will roll the dice and move the counter, and follow the square's instruction:

- -For True or False?: Players will complete the statement using the correct article and read it aloud. For every correct answer they will earn 1 point.
- For Talk About: Players will complete the sentence using the correct article and will earn 1 point. Now if they speak about the topic for 30 seconds they will earn an (extra point). For every incorrect answer they will move back 2 squares. The game ends when one player reaches the finish line. The player with the most points wins. Let's play and learn!




2. मेरी पसंदीदा चीज़ का वर्णन

In this telling time puzzle, one piece of the puzzle displays various clock faces showing different times, while the other piece has written times. This activity reinforces both the concept of reading analog clocks and recognizing corresponding written times.
